Emergency Room is a “Hot & Sweaty” band project which combines traditional funk and elements of rock and jazz to a burning groove machinery that already appeals to a wide variety of listeners. The bandleader, drummer and composer Wolf Wolff, after a jam session in Munich (2003) with Joseph Bowie the mastermind and frontman of the infamous band Defunkt, was compelled to organize a special new band featuring Joseph and legendary bassist and vocalist Reggie Worthy, formerly with Tina Turner and countless premier acts throughout Europe and the world. With Joe and Reggie, Wolf found the best musicians in Munich and created

Emergency Room. The band recorded their debut CD, “Stay away from the elevator” and then performed their debut live concerts in Munich in 2004. In the meantime Emergency Room toured across Europe for many live concerts.

Bowie’s very special style of rap/vocals and his characteristic trombone sound along with the performance of a line up of outstanding musicians from New York and Munich/Germany, made this group a “must hear” since 2004. In the period between 2005 and 2009, two more CDs appeared. A hot and funky live CD titled “Live at the Culture Festival” (2007) and the latest studio recording named “The Funky Side of the Moon” (2009).
